Basildon Last panel of experts

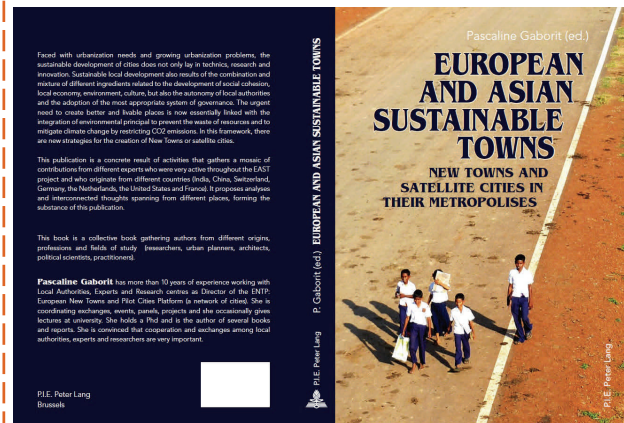
The third and last panel of experts of the EAST project has taken place in Basildon (UK) in March 2014.
